What is a cookie?

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. Piwik.org uses cookies to help Piwik.org identify and track visitors, their usage of Piwik.org website, and their website access preferences. Piwik.org visitors who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using Piwik.org's websites, with the drawback that certain features of Piwik.org's websites may not function properly without the aid of cookies.
